## **ETIQUETTE ON THE GOLF COURSE**

Etiquette covers both <u>Courtesy</u> and <u>Priority</u> on the Course as well as <u>Care of the Course</u>. Whilst the following points are not Rules as such they are an important part of the game.

✓	Don't move, talk or stand close to a player making a stroke.
✓	Replace the flagstick carefully.
✓	Don't play until the group in front is out of the way.
✓	Don't drop clubs on the putting green.
✓	Always play without delay. Leave the putting green as soon as all players in your group have holed out.
✓	Invite faster groups to play through.
✓	Replace Divots, Pitch Marks and Smooth Footprints in bunkers.

✓ Don't step on the line of another player's putt.
